Our most recent collaboration is still underway! The fine folks at **Open Sky Studio and Gallery** hosted an open house yesterday, to share their support for our mission and to highlight the importance of shopping local. Artists and gallery owners, **Percy Kleinops** and **Suzanne Elizabeth Murphy**, have donated a beautiful piece for our online auction, as well as committed to donating 25% of all proceeds from sales where WKPG is mentioned, between the holidays and January 31. We'll be holding a **town hall in the afternoon on February 24**, after our cleanup. We're still working on securing a location, but please mark your calendars! We'll share updates on how things are going, hold a Q&A session, and offer training for new and existing volunteers. 

Entire Panels of Ribbons Added to the Fence!


